




He had little education in the art field, but was greatly inspired by Rembrandt and other Masters. Challenged by colors and light, he transformed himself from being a painter to being an artist. Across his path, he was commissioned to SEINE RIVER VIEW / 18"x22" / OIL ON CANVAS create large historical and decorative works, becoming admired by his

Luce was a prolific French Neo-impressionist artist, known for his paintings, illustrations, engravings, and graphic art, and also for his anarchist activism. Starting as an engraver, he then concentrated on returning to Impressionism.

Metzinger's attractive career nurtured from the time France's art movements rapidly changed. He began as a neo-impressionist by virtue; he soon evolved under the influences of Georges Seurat and Henri Cross, discovering his own form of Divisionism. Later on, he ventures into Fauvism and Cubism, revealing his need to explore new art forms. "Park" 1906, a successful pointillist composition, shows the skills he developed from each phase.



Boggio was a pioneering Impressionist painter from Venezuela. In 1864 he traveled to France and studied at the Lycée Michelet in 1870 and the Académie Julian in 1877, where he received lessons from Jean-Paul Laurens. He obtained the 1888 Honorable Mention from the Académie des Beaux-Arts in Paris and NERVI SEAPORT 1910/14"x18"/OIL ON PANEL in 1889 the Bronze Medal at the Exposition Universelle.

Dumont was a French painter of the Rouen School, and a student of Joseph the Société Normande de Peinture Moderne 1909. He subsequently turned towards Cubism and played a crucial role in the organization of the Salon de la Section d'Or at the Galerie La Boétie 1912 in Paris.

Lhote was a painter and a sculptor who began as a Fauvist, under the influence of Gaugin and Cezzane. Later on in his career, he came under the influence of modern masters, such as Marcel Duchamp and Jacques Villon, soon adopting the Cubist style to his paintings and becoming one of their group.
